An Arts and Crafts silver and gemstone brooch

An Arts and Crafts silver and gemstone brooch, attributed to Dorrie Nossiter. A lozenge shaped brooch with a pair of open wire scrolls to the centre, surrounded by graduated blue zircons, cabochon turquoise and cabochon green agates, all rub set in plain collets, with polished beads between, 39 x 29mm

Condition Report

All gemstones present. Settings appear secure, although it may be wise to have them double checked. The roller section of the clasp is deficient (the locking section) although still hooks in. Very tarnished. Facet edge wear to the zircons. Slight variations in the shade of the turquoise. "C" catch intact, but may require adjusting.
