A Continental gold

A Continental gold, diamond and ruby bracelet, c.1950, with a central boss composed of an old European cut diamond, claw set to the centre, surrounded by scattered circular mixed cut rubies between Florentine textured leaves. The gathered centrepiece to a bracelet of fine graduated wires with Milanese borders, to a concealed box clasp with a pair of figure of eight safety catches. Israeli 750 standard mark. Marked 18k. Maker's mark unidentified. 186mm long, 19mm at the widest point, 44.08g

Condition Report

Tarnish to the leaf. Coil to the bracelet deficient 17mm from the tongue end. Clasp secure.
