A Victorian Etruscan Revival, gold, pietra dura pendant, c.1870, with a glazed locket verso. A circular pietra dura plaque with inlaid hardstone carnations, rub set to a pentagonal frame with applied bead clusters and fine work scrolls to a matching wide 'V' shaped bale. All to a bloomed ground with glazed hinged locket verso, damage. Dimensions 62 x 44mm, 20.62g

Condition Report

The mark at the right hand side was dirt, and has been removed from the surface. Some dents to the bale and the reverse of the bale. Split to the side wall at the lower right point, with a crease to the reverse. Hair panel a little loose.
