A cased Arts & Crafts sterling silver and gold citrine bracelet

A cased Arts & Crafts sterling silver and gold citrine bracelet, c.1960,

by Sibyl Dunlop. An emerald cut citrine, milligrain set to a plain collet with a series of hinged strapwork heart-shaped open links to each side. Applied gold-faced leaves with incised decoration with applied gold flower heads and beads to a concealed box clasp, with a gold tongue and figure of eight safety clasp. Hallmarked sterling silver, London 1964, with Sybil Dunlop maker's mark. Signed 'S. Dunlop' to the tongue, case 'Sibyl Dunlop, 69 Kensington Church Street, London, W8'. 171mm long, 40.54g

The case had sellotape stuck to the outside, which has removed the surface. S DUNLOP to the gold tongue. SD punch mark to the back of the silver strapwork links. See additional images (on request).
