A Victorian silver

A Victorian silver, gold and pearl hinged bangle, c. 1850, of naturalistic branch form. The textured silver branch with applied gold leaves with a crossover head, with a large gold leaf with trailing vine. Textured decoration with a white champlevé enamel ground and a bunch of grapes formed from plum and taupe coloured graduated pearls. Pearls untested. Tested as silver and 9ct gold. Interior diameter 9 x 50mm, 37.22g.

Condition Report

Unusual and I have not seen another bangle quite like it. Not marked in any way. Construction and style suggest it is probably British. Some losses to the white enamel. Tarnished. No other obvious damage. Interior diameter 9 x 50mm
