A late Victorian gold-mounted ribbon fob

A late Victorian gold-mounted ribbon fob, with a 9ct gold late Edwardian seal to one end, suspended from a chased gold split ring, c.1830. The grosgrain black ribbon fob with pierced spandrels to each end, with swivel clip to one end and split ring to the other. The hollow repoussé seal of navette form, Chester 1912. The fob marked 18. 183mm long, 17.60g

Condition Report

Fob alone approximately 6.40g Very small holes to the ribbon, where the points of the spandrels have pierced through.
