**A late 18th century two row garnet set rivière with a
garnet set cruciform pendant**

A late 18th century two row garnet set rivière with a garnet set cruciform pendant, the rivière composed of two row oval, foil backed, flat cut garnets, each one set in cut down collets, all joined by jump rings, one section uniform and the larger section graduated. The cruciform pendant with flat cut, foil backed, circular and pear cut garnets, in cut down collets to a concealed box clasp. Tested as approximately 9ct gold. 425mm long, cross 50 x 43mm, 49.64g

Condition Report

In good condition. Some scratches to the flat backs of each garnet. Colours of garnets vary within piece. Some claws some wear but no obvious other faults. Possible antique repair to one link.
