A collection of Tibetan jewellery,

19th century, inlaid with sapphires, rubies, emeralds, quartz and turquoise, on a metal ground with scrolls in gilt, 4.2 to 17.2cm long (7)

Condition Report

Various gems missing.

Surface scratches and dents.

In the UK, these would have been traditionally foiled with coloured foil behind the stones to intensify the colour. As this is Asian, there is coloured paste/paint used as a bed below the stone. Naturally, the stones are low grade and low saturation, possibly near colourless.

Base metal worn with parcel gilding.
