A collection of silver and plated items, comprising Tiffany and Co silver serving spoon and fork in the Queen's pattern, marked 'Tiffany & Co, Sterling, Pat 1885M', the spoon approx 25cm long, a twin handled sugar bowl, maker Goldsmiths' and Silversmiths' Co, London 1902', of urn form, with milled edges and detail to handles, with engraved initials B&F within a C, 5cm high, 11.5cm diameter (including handles), an oval pierced bonbon dish, maker's mark rubbed, Sheffield 1927, of oval form, 10.5cm wide by 7cm deep, a sugar bowl, maker FS over JH, London 1892, of circular half fluted form, 6cm high, 8.5cm diameter, a continental silver bowl, marked '835, A Collet' of octagonal form, 4cm high, 11.5cm diameter, and unmarked white metal dish set to the centre with an Emmanuel de Rohon 30 Tari coin, 8.5cm diameter, together with silver plated dishes, jugs, a chamberstick etc, approx 14ozt 4dwt silver weight
