A rose gold amethyst and pearl bracelet, c.1910, with a series of cut corner step cut amethysts, each one milligrain set in a plain collet. All joined by two rows of trace chain, each with a baroque pearl and gold wire to the centre. With a concealed box clasp and safety chain. Marked 9ct, *pearls untested*, 11.50 to 11.80mm wide, 11.86g

Condition Report

Clasp in working order.

Light surface marks commensurate with its age.

Table and crown facet edge wear.

Some of the wires through the pearls slightly bent.

Part of the tongue detached from the push piece - advise that this is repaired prior to being worn.

187mm long.

The collets are solid so you cannot see the depth of the stones.
