A sterling silver enamel butterfly brooch,

A sterling silver enamel butterfly brooch, Birmingham 1918, maker's mark EAP&Co, 85mm wide, together with a smaller sterling silver enamel butterfly brooch, by J Aitkin & Son, Birmingham 1918, and three silver enamel feather brooches, each 60 to 78mm long (5)

Minor surface marks/scratches/tarnish to silver of all.

Large butterfly: a couple of minor chips to the body of the butterfly. No apparent damage to wings.

Small butterfly: no apparent damage to enamel. Pin and 'C' catch bent.

Feather brooches: some chips to the enamel at the edges of all three. The chips are not immediately obvious to the naked eye, but can be seen under 10x magnification.
