**A Victorian 18ct gold opal and diamond ring,** with a row of three graduated oval cabochon opals, with a pair of brilliant and eight cut diamonds between each, all claw set to a 'D' section shank, Birmingham 1898, 3.04g.

### **Condition Report**

The two outer opals are possibly later replacements.

Two of the diamonds are later replacements - there is one old eight cut, one old brilliant cut, and two later replacement modern eight cuts.

Some surface reaching inclusions to the old brilliant cut.

All three opals are abraded, would benefit from being polished.

Some chips to the bottom edge of the outer two opals.

Some of the claws show signs of having been retipped
