A Victorian gold split pearl and enamel star,

A Victorian gold split pearl and enamel star, later converted to a brooch, with a cluster of split pearls grain set at the centre, to border of blue guilloché enamel, to later pin and roller catch, tested as approximately 15ct gold with 9ct gold fittings, 31mm long, 5.85g

Condition Report

Later converted, possibly from a locket or bangle.

Surface marks/scratches to gold.

Some gaps in solder seam between back plate and sides.

Some chips to the enamel.
