An 18ct gold three stone tourmaline ring, with three cabochon tourmalines, claw set to a tapering naturalistic wire form head and shank, London, possibly 2002, head 17mm wide, 10.83g

Due to shape of ring and wire formation, the ring cannot be measured on a ring stick. Based on the diameter of the ring, we estimate the finger size to be approximately T-U. Surface reaching inclusions to some of the tourmalines. Very minor marks to gold. No apparent damage or repairs.
