A gold pink tourmaline and diamond ring,
an oval mixed cut pink tourmaline, approximately 8.40 x 6.60mm, claw, with an old cut diamond grain set at each side, to split scroll shoulders terminating in an eight cut diamond rub set to a plain collet, tested as approximately 18ct gold, 4.95g.

Finger size L

Condition Report

Surface marks/scratches to mount.

Some nibbles and facet junction wear to the pink tourmaline.

French marks: horse's head (1838-1919), with letter M, and lozenge maker's mark, initials G P, unidentified.

White collets tested as approximately platinum.

Ring circa first quarter of the 20th century.

Pink tourmaline is possibly a later replacement.
